Personally, the last year has been one of transitions. In November 2020, I went to Detroit to visit my mother, who's health was declining. When I arrived, I sensed the Lord say, "Stay until the cloud moves." Think of the Israelites being directed by God in the wilderness (Numbers 9:15-23). My 10-day trip turned into a 75-day trip.

Here's what was hidden behind "the cloud."



- "Lord if I am going here for more than a visit, I will need a ministry (in addition to His Wheels International)." Wait, what did I say? The question shocked me as I headed to Midland, Michigan to visit Edith, my Jr. Hi Sunday School teacher.
- "I want to start a ministry of getting guitars around the world like you've gotten trikes around the world." Virgil said, when he stopped by his mom's (Edith's) house. Our brainstorming ended with my saying, "I've been looking for a guitar for Tanya, a Zimbabwean student living in Wheaton." Virgil said, "Come back in two weeks and I will have the guitar."
- When picking up the guitar, I realized God was leading me to move. As you can see, the first guitar Beacon Instrument (BI) gave away to Tanya, struck a chord! BI fulfills part of HWI's ministry—helping others actualize their dream. Part of Virgil's dream is for guitars to be built in vocational technical school settings.
- One January morning, I called a Midland realtor. She told me "There are no houses on the market!" A few hours later she called back to say, "I think I found your house!"

The Next Chapter Begins

After my new house inspection, I returned to Illinois to pack my house and His Wheels International, purge, and put my house on the market. Four weeks later, I returned to Detroit, for Mom's final 18 days of life.

In April, I sold my home of 23 years, said good-bye to Illinois after 40 years, sorted through my childhood family home in Detroit of 58 plus years and moved to Michigan. It's been a wild God ride!
